

Minutes April 14, 2016

M. Schulz called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., Thursday, April 14, 2016.

It was moved by G. Radke, seconded by D. Blackman to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

It was moved by G. Radke, seconded by L. Abel to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried. The current balance in the General Fund is \$40,777.78 and the balance in the Special Events account is \$7,470.57.

Planning and Zoning:

Dennis Yell - no new items on the Planning and Zoning agenda to report. Travel trailers were discussed.

Old Business:

L. Abel reported that we had been approved to receive the MN DNR grant for watercraft inspection by DNR staff. This will give us 180 hours of watercraft inspections on weekends, between May 14 and July 16 at the East Shore access. M. Schulz also reported that the Polk County AIS Taskforce has been considering installing cameras at lake accesses to monitor watercraft.

The Board discussed permitting of golf carts. At this time the responsibility of issuing permits lies at the township level and the Board would prefer the county issue the permits.

It was moved by M Schulz, seconded by G. Radke to keep the mosquito spraying schedule as is and monitor the conditions and requesting additional sprays as needed. The scheduled spray dates for the 2016 season are: May 25, June 8, 22 and 29, July 6 and 20, August 3 and 17. Motion carried.

It was moved by L. Abel, seconded by D. Blackman to adjourn, meeting at 7:45 p.m.
