

Minutes October 9, 2014 Minutes

Maple Lake Improvement District

President Schulz called the meeting to order at 7 P.M. October 9, 2014. Present were board members D. Beauchamp, D. Blackmun, B. Floan, M. Moore, G. Radke, M. Schulz, B. Wavra, and sec/treasure D. Rosenberg. Absent was D. Yell representing P & Z. Wavra made a motion to approve the agenda with Radke seconding. The motion carried. Radke made a motion to approve the September 2014 minutes and the treasure's report with Moore seconding. The motion carried. There is currently 20834.67 in the general fund and 9822.44 in the special events fund.

Kris Svalesson has requested a CUP to install a stool in the garage. The board has no problem with this. Tony Scheving is requesting a variance and the board has no problem with this if the DNR approves. The board had no opinion on James Hutton's variance request. Looking at the aerial photos they thought there could be a boundary dispute. Ron Bergman has requested a variance to construct another building next to one already on the property. The board was against this as it would look to commercial. Beauchamp made a motion to inform P & Z of their opinions with a second from Floan. The motion carried. Rosenberg will contact P & Z.

In old business Radke contacted Wild Rice and was told they would be using LED lights and they felt that it would not bother the Johnson's that much. Beauchamp made a motion to have the lights installed with a second from Blackmun. The motion carried. The DNR has approved putting the aerators in as early as January 1, 2015 if need be.

In new business Beauchamp made a motion with Floan seconding to move the time of the meetings from 7:00 PM to 6:00 PM November through March. The motion carried.

Floan made a motion to adjourn with Radke seconding. The meeting adjourned at 7:30.
