Lowell & Linda Hurtt on Maple Lake Dr SE requested a Variance to reduce the setback off the right of way to 24' of Maple Lake Dr SE and to 20' off the right of way of 125th Ave SE to construct a garage. The board had concerns about the structure being too close to the road and blocking vision of the intersection.

Old Business:

The board discussed additional mosquito spraying and it was moved by L. Abel, seconded by B. Floan to add sprays on August 9, 24 and 31. Motion carried.

New Business:

Lake resident, Fern Letnes, appeared before the board with concerns on various lake issues. She was glad to see that the Board was concerned with Planning and Zoning items and was also concerned with the weeds in the lake. The Board also has concerns with the weeds.

The board discussed a street light to be installed at the Polk County boat landing on the East Shore. M. Schulz was going to see if the AIS Board would cover the cost of installation in the amount \$713.00 with MLID covering the monthly electric costs.
