MLID Board Update

The MLID Board is concerned with the water quality of Maple Lake. They have been busy this winter meeting with Polk County Soil and Water and Red Lake Watershed representatives discussing areas of the lake where run off of phosphorus and chemicals is a problem and what can be done to reduce or eliminate this.

The board discussed their willingness to help share the cost of some of these projects if needed. They asked the representatives to work on identifying problem spots and to bring them back to the board along with some ideas to solve the problems.



The aerator was installed on January 12th on the Maple Bay end of the lake. This aerator ensures that the oxygen remains at a safe level and the board tests the oxygen level throughout the winter.

The board will be testing the water each month this summer and will send the samples to RMB Laboratories. If you want to see the results, go their website: www.rmbel.info.

Be Safe and Considerate While Boating This Summer

Recreational boats create wonderful opportunities for memorable times with family and friends. But owning a boat also carries certain responsibilities, and smart boat owners should know how to keep their guests safe on the water. Here are some Do's and Don'ts to remember while boating:

- **Do** wear your life jacket and have enough life jackets for everyone on board. Children less than 10 years old are required to wear a life jacket
- **Do** keep your engine turned off while people are in the water around the boat.
- Do keep a look out for other boaters and swimmers while you are underway.
- **Do** follow the boating etiquette rules.
 - You are responsible for your own wake and any damage done by it. Stay a safe distance from docks and swim rafts when boating.
 - Remember to register your swim rafts and put reflectors on them.
 - Respect your neighbors (day & night). If you have a loud boat, or music onboard, make sure you leave plenty of space. Sound carries much farther on the water, and you can be heard clearly from a good distance away.

- **Don't** drink if you will be driving.
- **Don't** overload your boat
- **Don't** liter. Bring trash bags with you and use them.

Water-skiing, Tubing & Wake-Boarding Rules

- Water-skiing, tubing, wake-surfing and similar acts are prohibited between one-half hour after sunset to sunrise the following day.
- There must be an additional person on board to act as an observer.

Personal Watercraft Rules:

- Anyone operating or riding on a personal watercraft must wear a life jacket.
- Personal watercraft must travel at a slow, no-wake speed (5 mph or less) within 150 feet of nonmotorized boats, shore, docks, swim rafts or anchored boat.
- Operation of personal watercraft is allowed only from 9:30 a.m. to 1 hour before sunset.

Clean In Clean Out

When boating or fishing in Minnesota, protect your waters by following state aquatic invasive species laws

1. CLEAN all visible aquatic plants, zebra mussels, and other prohibited invasive species from watercraft, trailers, and water-related equipment before leaving any water access or shoreland.

2. DRAIN water-related equipment (boat, ballast tanks, portable bait containers, motor) *and* drain bilge.

live well and baitwell by removing drain plugs before leaving a water access or shoreline property. **Keep drain plugs out** and water-draining devices open while transporting watercraft.

3. DISPOSE of unwanted bait, including minnows, leeches, and worms, in the trash. It is illegal to release bait into a waterbody or release aquatic animals from one waterbody to another. If you want to keep your bait, you must refill the bait container with bottled or tap water.
