

Minutes October 10, 2019

President B. Floan called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., Thurs, Oct. 10, 2019.

It was moved by L. Abel, 2nd by M. Moore to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

It was moved by R. Behm, 2nd by J. Baune to approve the September 2019 minutes. Motion carried

It was moved by B. Wavra, 2nd by L. Abel to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried. The balance of the accounts as of September 30, 2019: General Fund - \$26,910.15. Special Events account - \$4,748.75.

Old Business:

Commissioner, Gerald Jacobson was at the meeting to discuss the oversized boat canopies. He has been looking into it and has talked to both the DNR and Planning and Zoning representatives. He told the board and residents that he would look into doing something through the county. The board will bring ideas of size restrictions for boat canopies to the next meeting and Commissioner Jacobson will be in attendance to discuss this further. He is optimistic that this concern can be resolved before spring.

Commissioner Jacobson also discussed the construction on the East Shore roadside park. The board mentioned that they were concerned about increased runoff into the lake with the new design and told Comm Jacobson that the county should look into some kind of drainage system or rain garden system to slow down and filter the runoff.

It was moved by L. Abel, 2nd by R. Behm that the current county regulations on septic system compliance are adequate and that the board does not need a rebate program for septic system compliance checks. Motion carried

New Business:

Loren Abel, representative on the county AIS Taskforce discussed the October meeting and reported that they are discussing having a decontamination unit available at the East Shore during the summer of 2020 for boaters to wash off their boats and trailers.

A complaint was submitted by a property owner regarding blue green algae and the subject of questionable building permits granted. The board tabled this discussion until November's meeting.

It was moved by J. Baune, 2nd by R. Behm to adjourn the meeting at 8:12 pm. Motion carried.
